



Paid Indigenous Student Internships at Royal Alberta Museum

Interested in developing valuable skills (and earning more than \$11,000) by working in one of Canada's best museums? The **Indigenous Student Museum Internship (ISMI)** program may be for you.

Offered by the Friends of Royal Alberta Museum Society, the internship invites **First Nations, Inuit and Métis post secondary students** to spend a summer exploring a field that inspires them at the Royal Alberta Museum.

Whether it is archaeology or botany, communications or conservation, education, geology, Indigenous studies, invertebrate zoology, mammalogy, ornithology, palaeontology, or Western Canadian history—there is a field for you.

If you're enrolled in a college or university program, identify as First Nations, Inuit or Métis, and have related academic interests, you could be eligible.

This year's program runs for 16 weeks, **beginning in May 2020.**

Your application package should include:

- a completed application form;
- a cover letter outlining your field of study and why you would like a museum learning experience;
- two references;
- a recent academic transcript; and,
- your resume.
